Europe

Italy

Florence – [SAI Programs – Florence University of the Arts](#)

Florence University of the Arts is a young, vibrant institution in the heart of the Renaissance. This program is for students studying Hospitality, Tourism, and Gastronomy. FACULTY-LED PROGRAMS

Asia

India – [Yamuna River Study in India](#)

3 credits for BIOL 344 - counts for **GEP Goal Area 10**. The Yamuna River Study in India faculty-led course offers students interested in ecology, microbiology and/or public health the opportunity to travel to India to sample and study the holy Yamuna River. No prior experience is necessary. Takes place over the summer (14 days in May) and students will travel to New Delhi, Derhadun, Paonta Sahib, and Agra.

Europe

Italy - [Dante in Italy](#)

3 credits for ENG 221 or ENG 432. ENG 221 counts toward **Goal Areas 6A and 8**. Takes place during Summer (18-21 days in May) Students will explore the connection between the culture of Florence, Italy and Dante's Commedia (The Divine Comedy).

United Kingdom - [Global Literature in London/Travel writing & the British Imagination in London](#)

3 credits for ENG 221 or ENG 324. ENG 221 counts toward **Goal Areas 6 and 8**. Takes place during Summer (4-5 days in Winona followed by 14-16 days in London in June or July) Students will study London's leadership, culture, geography, politics, and customs. Students will visit popular and uncommon sites in and out of London and meet Brits from all walks of life involved in theatre and literary arts, visual arts, street art, folklore, governance, religion, music, commercial art, education.

North America

Jamaica - [Child Welfare, Health Systems, and Social Justice in Jamaica](#)

3 credits for NURS 316 or SOCW 316. These courses count toward **Goal Area 8**. Takes place during Winter Break (13-15 days in December/January). Students use a trans-cultural approach to learn about child welfare systems, with an emphasis on human rights, social justice, and health systems in Jamaica and US.

Interning abroad is an exciting opportunity to gain valuable cross-cultural work experience, understand international perspectives in your field, and live in another country for a summer or semester. All internships are taken for credit, allowing financial aid to be used.
