Sorrento - Sant'Anna Institute - Direct Enroll

Sant'Anna institute is in Sorrento, Italy which is on the Amalfi coast. The institute offers stunning views of the Gulf of Naples from each classroom. The school grounds are a short walk from the historic center of town. The courses offered related to geoscience are Marine Biology, Introduction to Volcanology, Introduction to Geology, and Marine Conservation.

Dunedin - API Full Curriculum at University of Otago in Dunedin

The University of Otago in Dunedin has been top rated by international students. The University offers field work experience in Geological Science. This University also consistently offers seminars from national and international executives such as New Zealand's deputy Prime Minister. Take Geoscience classes like Modern and Ancient Sedimentary Systems, Tectonics, and Field Studies and New Zealand Geology.

Wellington - API Full Curriculum at Victoria University of Wellington

Study at one of the Asia-Pacific region's most progressive and dynamic universities offering a wide range of studies and many interdisciplinary offerings. Gold Coast is a fast-growing metropolis and one of Australia's most popular tourist destinations which makes it a great city to study abroad in. Study Abroad students who attend this program are eligible for Griffith's prestigious Honours College. This University offers courses such as Antarctica: Unfreezing the Continent, Petrology and Microscopy, and Frontiers of Paleobiology.
