Asia

<u>China</u>

Hong Kong – University of Hong Kong (Exchange)

The University of Hong Kong is the territory's oldest institute of higher learning and also an internationally recognized, research-led, comprehensive university. Exchange students take classes in English and can learn Mandarin or Cantonese. Physics courses include Problem Solving in Physics, Theoretical Physics, and Astrophysics.

Tokyo – Sophia University (Exchange)

Takes Physics courses like Thermodynamics, Introduction to Quantum Mechanics, and Electromagnetism.

Florence, Venice - Taste of Italy

6 credits: ART 313 (3 credits) and ART 398/ART 299 ART 313 counts towards **Goal Areas 6B and 8** Takes place during Summer (15-18 days in May) Students will learn about and focus on art, design, visual culture and lifestyle in contemporary Italy, against the backdrop of its rich ancient history.

6 credits in ART 313 and ART 398 Take place during Summer (14-17 days in May/June) Students will explore Berlin and its transformation through the lens of messaging that Germany used to shift the paradigm following the Nazi Regime with an incorporated critique of white supremacy and ethnic cleansing

4 credits for GS 350 Takes place during Summer (13-16 days in June/July) Students will examine and study the complex culture and diversity on the Puerto Rican Island.
