Botswana

Gaborone – <u>CIEE Community Public Health Program</u>

With one of Africa's most vital healthcare systems, Botswana is an ideal place to explore regional, social, and scientific health issues. Gain hands-on experience and further your understanding of biology, development, medicine, and public health. Public Health courses include Public and Environmental Issues in Botswana, Community Health Practicum, and Basic Toxicology.

Senegal

Examine health care systems, the management and prevention of disease, and the philosophical approaches to health care, including the role of traditional medicine, through the Health theme. Specific topics for discussion may include holistic health, women's and children's health, public health, animal health, and rural vs. urban health care facilities.

France

Australia

Adelaide – IFSA – University of Adelaide

Public Health courses include Health and Illness in Populations, 21st century Infectious Disease Epidemiology and Control, and Promoting Health in Individuals and Populations.

New Zealand

FACULTY-LED PROGRAMS

England and Ireland - Health, Exercise, & Medicine: An International Perspective (England & Ireland)

3 credits for HERS 305. HERS 305 counts toward Goal Area 8. Takes place during Summer (16-21 days in June/July). Students will learn about medicine, health and exercise in a society outside of the United States.

France - The Business of Healthcare: A Comparison of Healthcare Systems in Paris

3 credits for HADM 376. Takes place during Summer (10-12 days in May). Students study major aspects of healthcare in an international context. Major topics include healthcare infrastructure including integrative health and public health, nutrition, exercise, service, advertising, healthcare data analytics, and more.

Jamaica - Child Welfare, Health Systems, and Social Justice in Jamaica

3 credits for NURS 316 or SOCW 316. These courses count toward Goal Area 8. Takes place during Winter Break (13-15 days in December/January). Students use a trans-cultural approach to learn about child welfare systems, with an emphasis on human rights, social justice, and health systems in Jamaica and US.
