*The English proficient test score is not required for the Japanese Language Courses applicants.

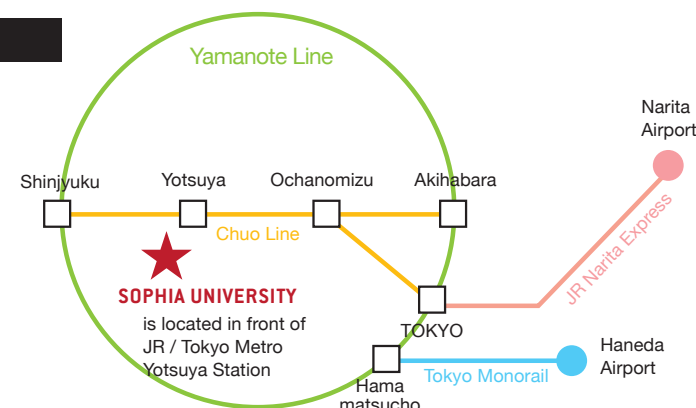
